Recognition of Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program

This is to confirm that RMIT University recognises the Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program for entry to RMIT vocational education and undergraduate degree programs.

We have developed the equivalency tables detailing the comparative Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program grade that students are required to achieve in academic and prerequisite course requirements, for entry to RMIT programs.

Admission to RMIT is subject to meeting the [program entry requirements](#), visa requirements, the University's [Simplified Student Visa Framework](#) policy and availability of places in the program.

Academic Entry Equivalencies

The table below details the Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program academic equivalent requirements:

Applied Mathematics: Engineering and Science	Further Mathematics	
Statistics and Probability	Data Handling, Statistics and Information Technology*	To enter Associate Degree, student must achieve an average of 40%; To enter Bachelor Degree, student must achieve an average of 52%.

*Data Handling, Statistics and Information Technology has two different units offered based on streams, Data Handling, Statistics and IT for Humanities, Business and non-STEM Maths pathways or Data Handling, Statistics and IT for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) pathways. Both match RMIT Foundation program course Statistics and Probability.

English Language Entry Requirements

Students who have completed the Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program must meet the RMIT standard English requirements by submitting an accepted English proficiency test results with the satisfactory score. RMIT's English requirements are located [here](#).

Other Requirements

Some RMIT programs have additional requirements for admission (e.g., selection task for design programs) or immunisation and professional compliance requirements (for programs with medical/professional placements). Applicants should refer to the individual program entry requirements to find out if this applies to their preferred program.

Application Process

Applicants are expected to follow the standard RMIT application process and will receive a letter of offer from RMIT. Applicants are required to submit academic transcripts as part of their application. Go [here](#) for detailed information on how to apply.

This is effective from the above date and will remain in effect for so long as the Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program is offered. RMIT should be notified at least 6 months in advance of any changes to the Kings Education Advanced Level Foundation Program.
